

COVID-19 hospitalization capacity in Trauma Region F

including Delta County, has exceeded 15% for 7 consecutive days. Under Governor Abbott's Executive Order 32, this triggers a roll back in restrictions including the reduction of business capacity to 50%. Counties affected by this include Hopkins, Bowie, Cass, Delta, Lamar, and Titus Counties.

Trauma Region F

Bowie, Cass, Delta, Hopkins, Lamar,
Morris, Red River and Titus Counties

Day 1 - 12/27 - 15.47%

Day 2 - 12/28 - 17.23%

Day 3 - 12/29 - 15.96%

Day 4 - 12/30 - 15%

Day 5 - 12/31 - 17.05%

Day 6 - 1/1 - 19.03%

Day 7 - 1/2 - 18.63%

Day 8 - 1/3 - 19.48%

Our region has been added to the DSHS list of regions that 15% or more of total hospital capacity has been COVID-19 patients. <https://www.dshs.texas.gov/ga32/>

If there are 7 consecutive days when the hospitalization percentage is above 15%, and customer capacity at local businesses has to decrease, then there has to be 7 consecutive days of the hospitalization percentage to fall below 15% in order to customer capacity to increase.

Non-consecutive days do not factor into the increase or decrease in customer capacity, as stated within the signed Executive Order by Texas Governor Greg Abbott.
